

Section 14: Service Charges for Temporary Service

- 1.0 Temporary power is available upon completion of an application for temporary service and paying all fees.
- 2.0 A minimum non-refundable temporary fee of \$150.00 is required by Utility to pay costs for connection and disconnection incidental to the supplying and removing of service. Additional costs may be incurred for any make-ready work necessary to provide temporary service that cannot be used for future, permanent service.
- 3.0 As the Customer, you are responsible for supplying and preparing the temporary pole, meter base, and wiring. Specifications for temporary service are available on the Utility's website or by contacting a representative of our Engineering Department. Temporary services must be inspected by State Deputy Inspector before connection.
- 4.0 Temporary services are billed under the General Services rate schedule or other applicable rate schedule. Temporary services will not be billed under a Residential rate schedule even if being used for construction of a residential dwelling.
